GCG General Information

The Genealogical Computing Group (**GCG**) is a Special Interest Group of the New Zealand Society of Genealogists Inc. (**NZSG**) and has several hundred members throughout New Zealand.

Our three key objectives are to:

- foster and encourage the use of computers as a tool for genealogical research,
- provide members with information and advice on the use of computers and their programs (which assist genealogical research),
- organise computer assisted projects related to the storage, retrieval and indexing of genealogical information.

The GCG is administered by a national committee elected at Annual General Meetings, responsible for :

- maintaining the membership database
- sponsoring and supporting the establishment of “**subgroups**”
- publishing a quarterly magazine - **GenCom News** - dispatched in March, June, September, and December.
- operating a magazine library,
- liaising with the New Zealand Society of Genealogists Inc.
- maintenance of our web site.

GCG Subgroups

are local organisations which operate wherever there are GCG members who wish to meet regularly.

Meetings can be formal and have a speaker on a genealogical computing topic or they can be run as a workshop with participation by members.

Meeting topics include:

- genealogical software,
- using computer programs for genealogy,
- the internet,
- computer peripherals
- and just about anything which includes genealogy and computing.

Beginners are especially welcome and there are opportunities to ask questions. Some subgroups host annual “Open Days” where the public are invited to view the resources and activities of members, and to consider joining the group.

An invitation to renew membership accompanies each December issue of **GenCom News**. New members joining during the year receive all the issues for that financial year, and back-numbers of GenCom News are also available while stocks last.
